

## STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

Executive Order No. 1 of 2020

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in Greene County effective 12:00 PM on March 15, 2020.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to the threat to public safety produced by the effects of the ongoing COVID-19 Virus, affecting all portions of the jurisdiction.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect for THIRTY (30) Days or until rescinded or extended by subsequent order.

As the Chairman of the Greene County Legislature, I Patrick S. Linger, exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render available assistance vital to the well-being and health of the citizens of Greene County.

Additional Emergency Orders will be promulgated by the Chairman of the Legislature during the State of Emergency in order to further protect life and property and to bring the emergency condition(s) under control.

## Notes:

- 1. This State of Emergency must be filed within seventy-two hours with the Clerk of the County legislature, Greene County Clerk, Office of the Secretary of State and the State Office of Emergency Management within the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services.
- 2. Anyone who knowingly violates any emergency order is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
