A recent listing for a property in the town of Catskill surprised the writers at Upstater.com as they found Greene County's median property taxes paid on homes is \$2,411 – just 1.29% of the median home value of \$187,600. An Interactive Map comparing taxes paid in all NY counties shows Greene County homeowners pay lower taxes as a percent of home value than those in any surrounding county, and significantly lower than downstate (Rockland's median property taxes paid on homes is over \$8,000).
