On Tuesday, August 6th, 2019, Moody's Investors Service upgraded Greene County's bond rating to Aa2, an improvement over the previous rating of Aa3, citing strong financial management as evidenced by consistently sound reserves, conservative budget management and a formal policy to maintain reserves. This rating puts Greene County among eight non-NYC counties with the rating of Aa2 or higher.

On Thursday, August 15th, 2019, Greene County sold a Public Improvement (Serial Bond) in the amount of \$39,000,000 for the construction of the County's Jail Facility. The results of the sale were very strong,

Recertification of Agricultural District 124

The Greene County Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Planning along with the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board (AFPB) has begun the mandated recertification process for Agricultural District 124 in accordance with the New York Agricultural Districts law. Greene County Economic Development, Tourism and Planning and the AFPB will be partnering with Cornell Cooperative Extension of Columbia-Greene Counties to survey Ag District 124 farmers to collect information about their farm operations. The county will conduct a thirty-day comment and open enrollment period from October 1, 2019
