

### In Memory Frederick Van Loan

On January 13, 2025, the GCVFA and Auxiliary lost more than a member; they lost a friend, when Fred VanLoan peacefully went to be with the Lord.

Frederick Arthur "Fred" Van Loan, a lifelong resident of Athens, was born on September 15, 1936, in Catskill, NY to Frederick and Myrtle Van Loan, Fred was a devoted father, cherished partner to Lillian Moore (Athens VFD Auxiliary), faithful servant to God and beloved member of his community. Fred took immense pride in his family and treasured every moment shared with them.

Fred's life was marked by service and dedication to his country and neighbors. A proud patriot, Fred served in the U.S. Air Force in 1961. He also served as Chaplain for the Athens Fire Department and Greene County Volunteer Firemen's Association for over 50 years, and was Commander of the Athens Legion Post from 1992 to 1996. He was a Lay Minister for the Federated Church of Athens, where he was a lifetime member, as well as involved in numerous organizations throughout Greene County. Fred's leadership extended to organizing Memorial Day parades and services that brought joy to the town he loved.


