Narrative

During the 2023-2024 academic year, the Greene Light to Enrollment Scholarship funded 74 students enrolled in both credit and non-credit courses at Columbia-Greene Community College. In the first half of the 2024-2025 academic year, the fund provided significantly greater access to students from Greene County, funding 89 students in the Fall 2024 semester, bringing the total from the program's inception to 353 Greene County students who have received \$358,600 in financial aid.

The original transportation grant made in 2020 has also seen an uptick in usage during the current 2024-2025 academic year with 200 bus passes already distributed by the Dean of Students office during the Fall 2024 semester.

With gratitude to the Greene County legislators and the taxpayers of Greene County for their continued support of this program that opens the door to financial accessibility to higher education,
