# **Greene County Authorizes First Steps** in Rebirth of Cementon



On Wednesday April 16, the Greene County Legislature unanimously adopted a resolution establishing the Cementon Redevelopment Capital Project and authorizing an application to the FAST NY grant program to fund a variety of studies and the creation of a master plan. This plan would serve as a guide to help the County best address the Cementon area's underutilized parcels and attract new businesses. James Hannahs, Director of Economic Development, Tourism and Planning called this resolution the first step in the creation of a "roadmap for the rebirth of Cementon," and noted that this study will "allow us to look at everything that is involved in large-scale land development and see if and what is viable in the area while also giving stakeholders the chance to come to the table and provide input."
