

NOTICE OF VACANCY

JOB TITLE: MOTOR EQUIPMENT OPERATOR (2 vacancies)

Employees in this class are responsible for the safe and efficient operations of moderately complex motor equipment. The incumbent receives general directions from a higher level employee, and is responsible for the safe and economical operation and care of the motor equipment on assigned tasks. The incumbent oversees the work of assigned employees. Receives periodic inspections of work in progress. When assigned to the Solid Waste Department, the incumbent may be required to perform the duties of the Transfer Station Operator in their absence. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

- Operates a tractor-trailer, trucks and other motor equipment such as; power mower, snow loaders, bulldozer, concrete mixer, stone crusher, power grader, steam roller, snow plow, or power shovel; excavator; roll-off trailer; forklift, loaders, compactors or other attachments;
- Maintains and services all assigned equipment and assists with the repairs;
- Performs manual labor, such as loading and unloading trucks, and various solid waste materials when required;
- Coordinates and oversees the work of subordinate staff engaged in loading and unloading trucks;
- Transports solid waste material to landfills and markets; erects snow fences, cleans culverts and shovels snow;
- Maintains and prepares simple records and reports when required;

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Good knowledge of the operation of tractor-trailers, trucks, tractors, and other automotive equipment and attachments; Ability to maintain, service, and assist with repairs of motor equipment; Ability to prepare and maintain records and reports; Ability to oversee and coordinate the work of subordinates; Ability to communicate both orally and in writing; Willingness to respond to emergencies and work under adverse weather conditions; Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a high equivalency diploma **and** possession of a valid New York State CDL or CDL Class A driver's license appropriate to the vehicle(s) operated at the time of appointment and for employment within Greene County Government only the incumbent must maintain this license throughout employment.

NOTE: Applicants or those eligible for original appointment to positions in the classified service in Greene County Government that receive a conditional offer of employment must successfully pass a background check and a drug screen.
